



BEES CONSERVATION VOLUNTEER PROGRAMME

We work on a number of urban and urban fringe sites, managing them for the benefit of wildlife and local people. We offer an opportunity for anybody interested in nature conservation or people keen to help maintain local areas and make a positive impact on the local environment and community. No previous experience is necessary; training will be given on the day. Please bring a packed lunch and wear suitable clothing if you intend to stay for the full day.

The meeting point for group travel to sites is YMCA Culture Fusion, 125 Thornton Road, Bradford, BD1 2EP (a few minutes' walk from City Park). If you would like a lift in the minibus please arrive before 10am. Sessions run from 10.30-3.30. If you need to borrow boots please let us know beforehand.

28th February	Woodside Academy, Fenwick Dr, Bradford, BD6 2PG. We will be completing the task of large-scale planting of a native hedge around the perimeter of the school grounds.
7 th March	Bradford Urban nature Reserve, Laisteridge Lane Student Village, Laisteridge lane, BD5 ONH. We will be carrying out tree and hedge planting where the fallen trees have been moved from, building habitat piles out of felled trees and clearing paths
14 th March	Bowling Park Community Orchard, in the allotments on Bowling Park Drive, BD4 7ET. Tasks include feeding the fruit trees, weeding under the tree canopies and other seasonal tasks.
21st March	Near Malham Tarn Tree planting in the Yorkshire Dales with The National Trust. We will be Leaving Culture Fusion at 9am and leaving Malham at 3, with a view to arriving back in Bradford between 5-5.30.
28 th March	Bradford Urban nature Reserve, Laisteridge Lane Student Village, Laisteridge lane, BD5 ONH. We will be building habitat piles from felled trees and clearing paths
