8 <sup>th</sup> August	Baildon Moor - Bingley Rd Car Park, Baildon, Shipley BD17 5EE continuing our annual bracken cutting to encourage a range of moorland plants to thrive. Please wear long trousers, sleeves and boots to provide protection from plants and insects.
